## Dear Parents,

- Just to keep you up to date on what is happening in our school.
- We would like to acknowledge the support of parents/guardians of our children in the

- If your child has to self-isolate and take time off school we would like you to come to the school, take his books home and continue with the plan of work assigned to him.
